Introduction:

The Ospedaletti Circuit is a historic international street circuit. Here automobile's and motorcycle's Grand Prix races were held featuring the most famous world champions from 1947 to 1972. It winds through the streets of the town of Ospedaletti, taking the names of the following roads:

- Corso Marconi
- Via Cavour
- Corso Regina Margherita

A distinctive feature of the Ospedaletti circuit is that it has preserved its original characteristics in terms of length and layout over the years. The circuit has always been affectionately referred to as "the Circuit" by both residents and tourists.

Since 2008 the Municipality of Ospedaletti with the active collaboration of the Circuit's Promoter Committee and the sponsorship of leading organizations dedicated to preserve motorsport heritage has organized a biennial Historic Motorcycle Road Show Reenactment with increasing volume participants each year.

It is the intention of the Municipal Administration and the Circuit Promoter Committee to create a new Historic Automobile Reenactment to fully revive the glory of this prestigious street circuit.

Art. 1 The Event Structure

The Municipality of Ospedaletti

- Is the Owner and Responsible Party for the Historic Automobile Reenactment of the “Sanremo Grand Prix – Ospedaletti Circuit.”
- Delegates certain activities to the Circuit Promoter Committee through a specific Agreement, approved by the Municipal Council.
- Delegates other activities to an Administrative Technical Commission, appointed by the Municipal Board.

The personnel of the Circuit Promoter Committee

- Offer their collaboration free of charge and on a voluntary, unpaid basis.

The event takes place under the auspices of ASI.

Art. 2 Nature of the event

The event

- Is NON-Competitive in nature and takes place on the historic Ospedaletti Circuit (Corso Marconi; Via Cavour; Corso Regina Margherita), which will be properly closed to traffic and delimited as per the Safety Plan prepared by the Municipality of Ospedaletti.
- Absolutely prohibits any competitive behavior from the participants.
- Speed on the circuit must be kept within safe limits appropriate to the track's characteristics and the age of the cars.

Art. 3 Participating Vehicles

The following vehicles are eligible to participate in the Historic Automobile Reenactment:

- Grand Prix, Sports, and "Barchette" cars up to 1960.
- All historical-sporting vehicles after 1960 particularly rare (subject to approval).
- The Operational Technical Committee, part of the Circuit Promoter Committee, will evaluate the registration applications. These must be submitted by filling out the online form available on the website www.circuitospedaletti.org Duly completed, signed and accompanied by the required documentation, to be submitted in accordance with the procedures outlined in Article 8.
- Priority will be given to the historical importance of the vehicles and the chronological order in which the registration applications are received.
- After compiling the list of accepted vehicles, the Operational Technical Committee will decide on the number of groups (batteries) and their composition, taking into account the characteristics of the vehicles.

Art. 3.1 Memorial of Amilcare Ballestrieri

A parade will be dedicated to rally cars that were present during his competitive history up until 1980.

Art. 4 "Green Card"

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to admit vehicles that do not meet the requirements outlined in Art. 3. These vehicles will be grouped with the historic batteries or placed in separate special groups at the sole discretion of the Operational Technical Committee.

Art. 5 Parades

The Circuit Promoter Committee reserves the right to organize one or more parades during the event on topics deemed appropriate, such as a brand-specific parade, honorary parade, commemorative parade, etc.

It will be at the discretion of the Circuit Promoter Committee to determine the themes and the timing of the parade during the event.

Art. 6 Vehicles, Drivers, and Passengers

Drivers must:

- Hold a valid driver's license
- Wear appropriate driving attire and an approved helmet
- Comply with the traffic regulations set by the organization on the route and in their assigned areas, maintaining a responsible and cautious driving behavior for the safety of people and property. Failure to comply may result in exclusion from the event and in more severe cases from subsequent editions of the Reenactment.

Each driver is responsible for the full technical functionality of the vehicle being used. The organizers will only provide the stickers with the assigned number to be placed on the vehicle. Access to the track will only be granted after the vehicle and the driver's attire have passed the technical checks.

Art. 7 Registration for the event

To participate in the Historic Automobile Reenactment, each driver must complete the online form available on the website www.circuitospedaletti.org filled out in all parts, signed and completed with all required attachments.

The form should be submitted to the following email address: comitatocircuitospedaletti@gmail.com, with the subject line formatted as follows: Name_Surname_Make_Model of the car.

Applications that are not signed and/or not fully completed, or those missing the required attachments, will not be considered. Applications must be received no later than July 31, 2025.

The completed registration form must be accompanied by the following required documents:

- Driver's license of the participant
- Medical certificate (a certificate from the general practitioner is sufficient) attesting to the physical fitness of the driver and passenger, or alternatively, a valid sports license at the time of the reenactment
- 4 color digital photos of the vehicle, showing:
 - Right side of the vehicle
 - Left side of the vehicle
 - Front of the vehicle
 - Rear of the vehicle

Note: Photos should depict the vehicle in the condition it will be in during the event.

Optional documentation:

- Racing history of the car
- Racing resume of the driver and/or passenger
- Description of the collection to which the car(s) belong to

Note: Submitted materials will not be returned, even if the vehicles are not accepted by the Technical Commission.

Art. 8 Registration Fee for the event

The registration fee for the third edition of the Historic Automobile Reenactment, is €500.00 (five hundred), to be paid by bank transfer upon acceptance of the registration. This fee includes the gala dinner for 2 people at a prestigious local restaurant selected by the Circuit Promoter Committee on Saturday, September 27 and 1 overnight stay in a double room at a hotel selected by the Circuit Promoter Committee.

Art. 8.1 Registration of additional vehicles driven by the same driver

In the case of registering two or more vehicles driven by the same driver an additional fee of €100.00 (one hundred) will apply for each vehicle.

Art. 8.2 Registration for the Memorial of Amilcare Ballestrieri

The registration fee for the parade dedicated to Amilcare Ballestrieri, excluding the gala dinner and overnight stay, is €100.00 (one hundred).

Art. 8.3 Gala Dinner – Additional guests

It is possible for additional guests to participate in the gala dinner. For each additional person fee is €60.00 (sixty). This fee must be paid at the time of registration via bank transfer.

Art. 9 Circuit Insurance

The Circuit Promoter Committee will take out a specific insurance policy for any damages to people and/or property attributable to the organization (e.g., failure to comply with the Safety Plan, accidents caused by oil leaks, straw bales, barriers, or unforeseen obstacles on the track, pedestrian crossings, etc.).

Art. 9.1 Vehicle Insurance during the event

Damages not attributable to the Organization, specifically those caused by irresponsible conduct of the driver and/or passenger will remain the exclusive and total responsibility of the participants.

Art. 10 Failure to participate in the event

Participants are required to promptly inform the organizers in case they are unable to attend the event or of any changes in the circumstances to allow the communication to be up to date.
